

Policies and Procedures of the SBRTTA

January 27, 2018

1. Dues shall be in the amount of \$5 per year.
2. The SBRTTA will provide balls. Members are expected to purchase their own paddles. Basic paddles are available for use prior to a member's receipt of their own paddle.
3. Play sessions shall be Tuesdays, Thursday, and Fridays, at 1:30-5:30pm.
4. SBR Residents (owners and renters) can request membership in the SBRTTA via the SBRTTA website.
5. Residents can play at Association sessions three times before deciding they wish to become members.
6. A requirement for membership and for playing prior to becoming a member is having a "hold harmless" waiver in effect and on record with the SBR HOA. No one is permitted to play at SBRTTA sessions without such a waiver in place.
7. Players are not to set up or take down tables because of the risk of damaging them. They are owned by the SBR HOA. The Fitness Center personnel perform these tasks.
